BOEING P-8 FACTORY TOUR

Seattle Navy League board members and invited guests were treated to a tour of the Boeing P-8 facility at Boeing Field, where the Navy's new anti-submarine warfare aircraft are fitted out. Board member and Boeing employee Fred Smith arranged the event, which featured a guided walk-through of the aircraft on the line. No pictures are allowed inside the facility, of course, so we've included a stock photo of the P-8 below. Built from a 737 airframe, the P-8 is replacing the venerable P-3 in the US Navy fleet as well as those of a number of our allies.

This was a great opportunity for us to see this important capability up close, an experience and information that will help us in our mission of supporting the Sea Services. In conjunction with other area councils, Seattle Navy League is planning more tours in the region for our members for 2019.
